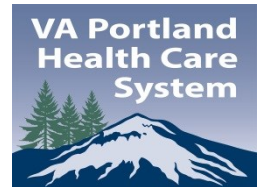

Each Fellowship screens candidates, the Fellowship Director has oversight and final approval over selection. Best-qualified applicants are those with prior experience in the emphasis area and with demonstrated ability to benefit from the Fellowship's training opportunities. All things being equal, consideration is given to top applicants with diverse backgrounds across Veterans' status, racial, ethnic, religious, sexual orientation, disability, or other underrepresented groups.

Research at VAPORHCS

VAPORHCS is a top setting for research funding. Each fellowship varies in its mix of clinical and research training; however, VAPORHCS encourages involvement in research activities. Fellows have opportunities to co-author publications and professional presentations and can take advantage of many resources associated with PVAMC's close ties to OHSU.
